Former Negotiator of USMCA Trade Agreements from the Embassy of Mexico in Washington, D.C.

Former General Director in the Mexican Government, particularly in the Minister of Economy, my participation in the Mexican Government was during 2013 to 2018.

During the time I was working in the Minister of Economy I had the opportunity to participate in the negotiations of the Transpacific Partnership Agreement (TPP), I was in charge of the negotiations chapters of Telecommunications, Movement of Natural Personas, Electronic Commerce and the Non-Conforming Measures (NCM's). Also an active participation in the ongoing negotiations of the Trade in Services Agreement (TISA). With the European Union I was chief negotiation of all the tables related to services and investment. With the US and CA (USMCA), I was chief negotiation of Financial Services, Currency and land transportation.

Other negotiations of FTA's, Turkey, Jordan, Brazil, and also negotiation of Bilateral Investment Treaties such as Philippines, Iran, Haiti.
