Funding Source: \$10 per Vehicle Registration Fee paid to the County

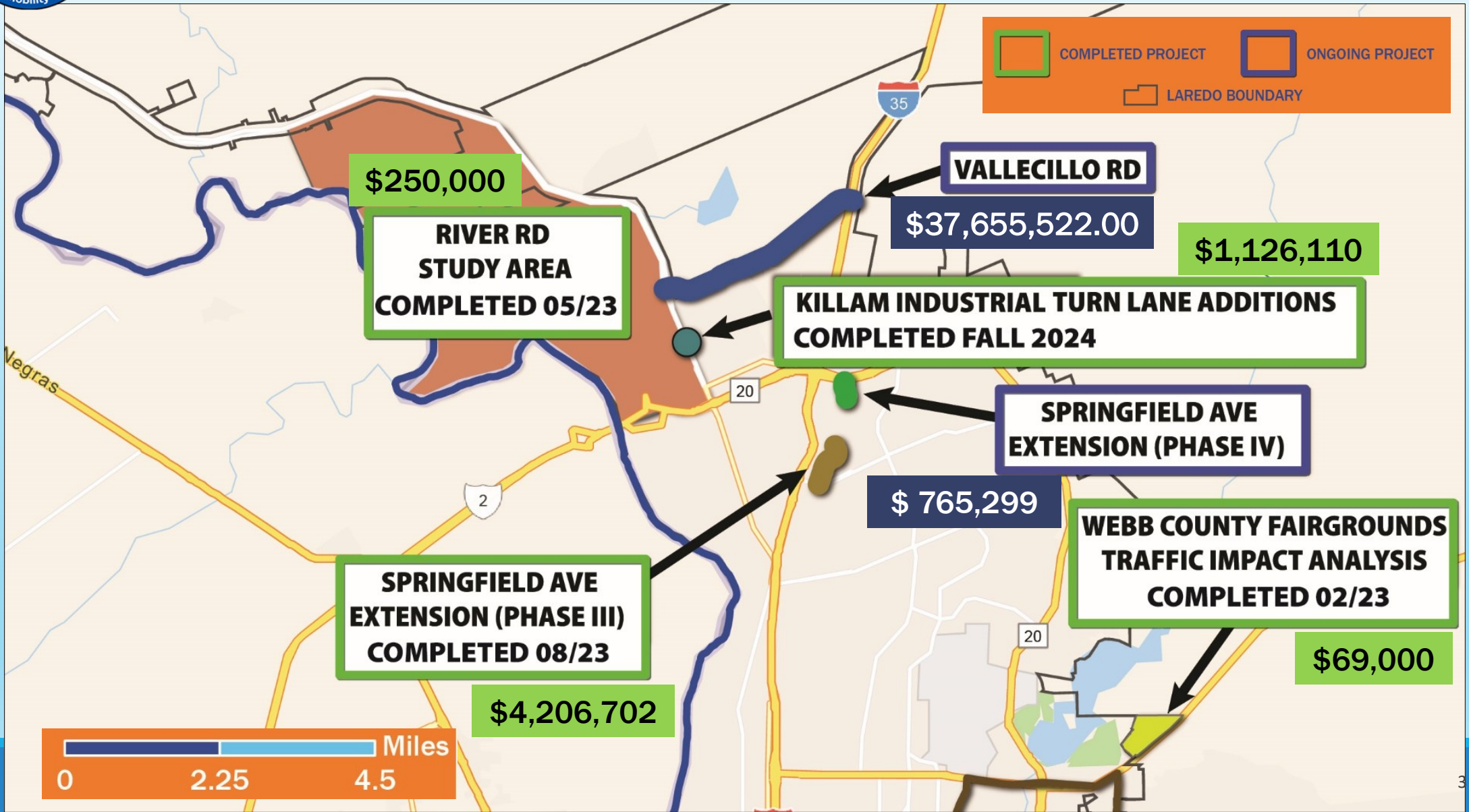


Composition of the Board:

- C. Webb County Commissioners Court

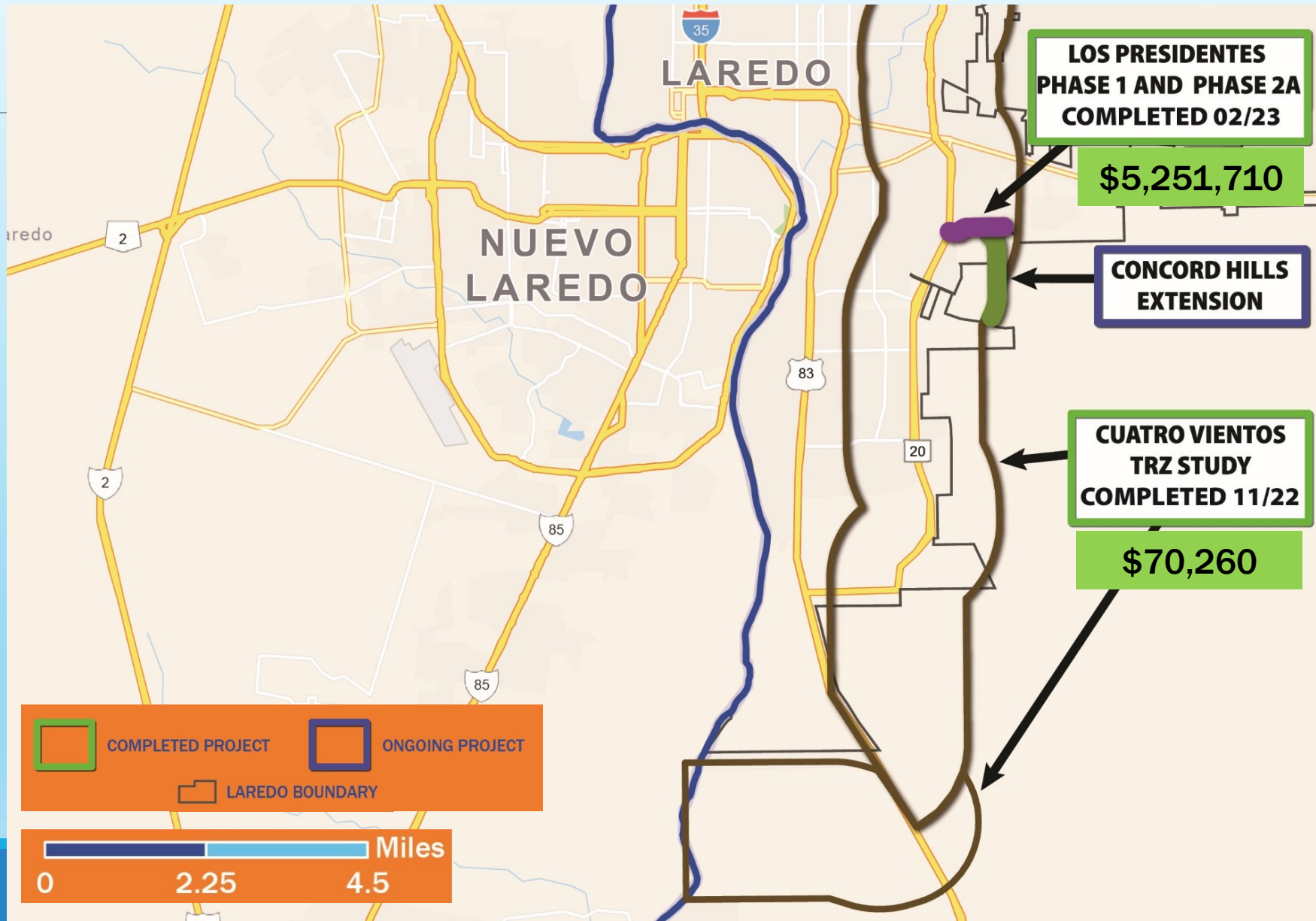


Webb County – City of Laredo RMA Projects 2022 - 2025

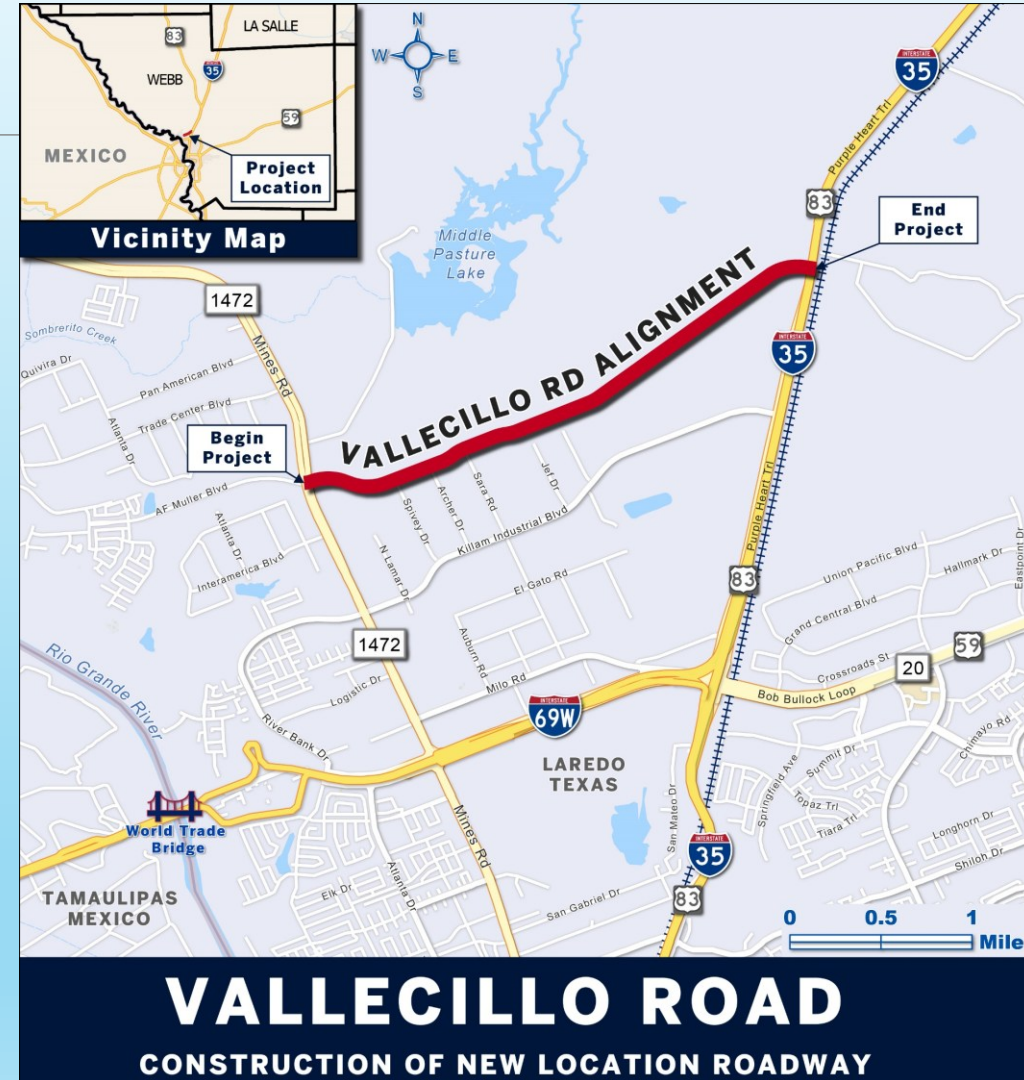

Vallecillo Road continued

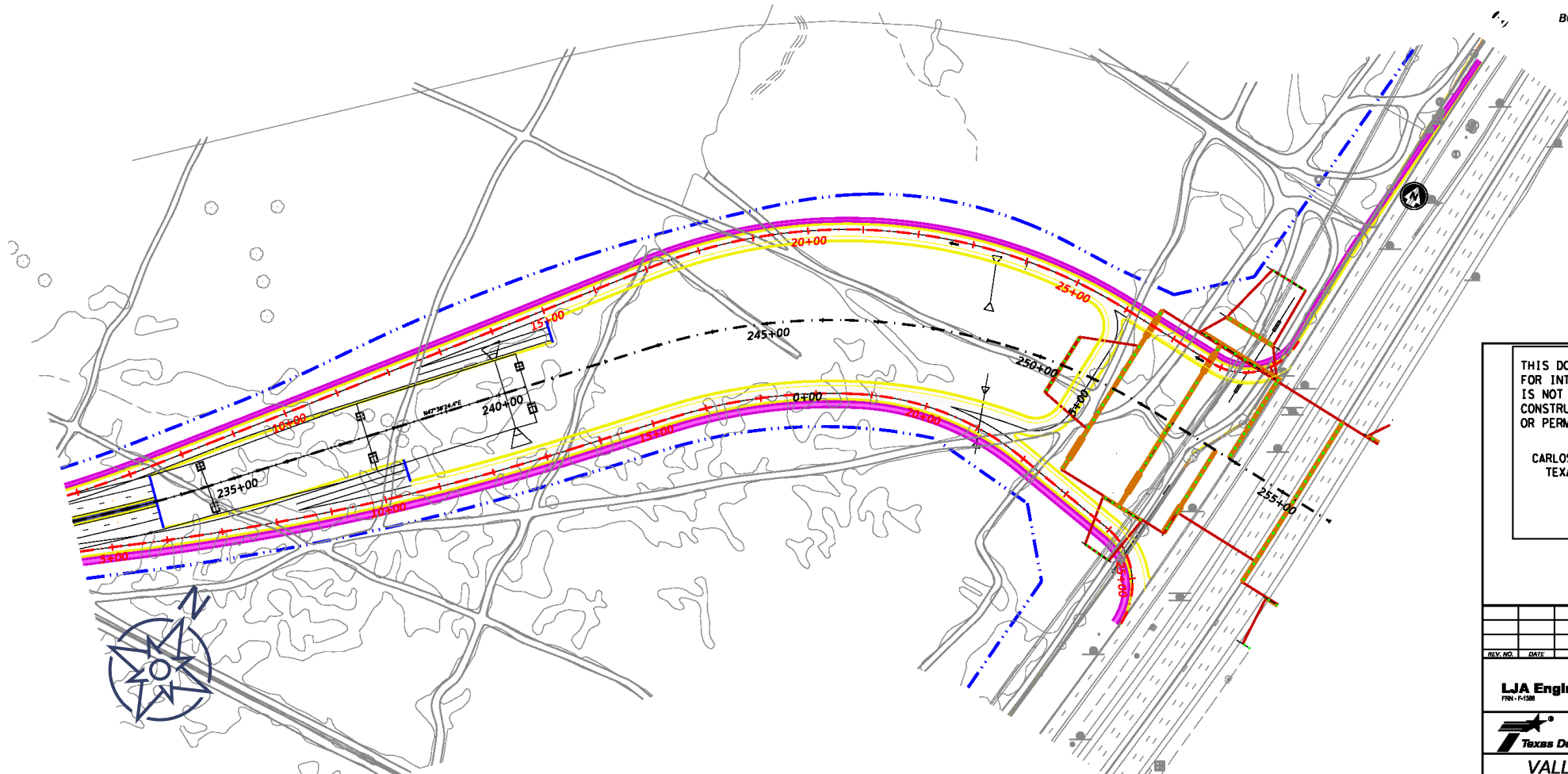
- 45% PS&E to properly align with TxDOT Vallecillo Overpass at IH35

- Estimated construction completion: Summer 2029

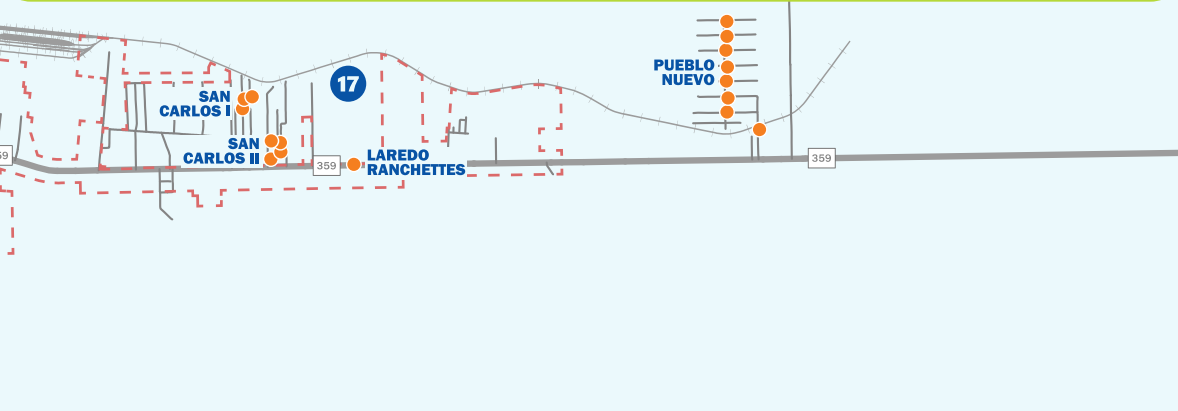

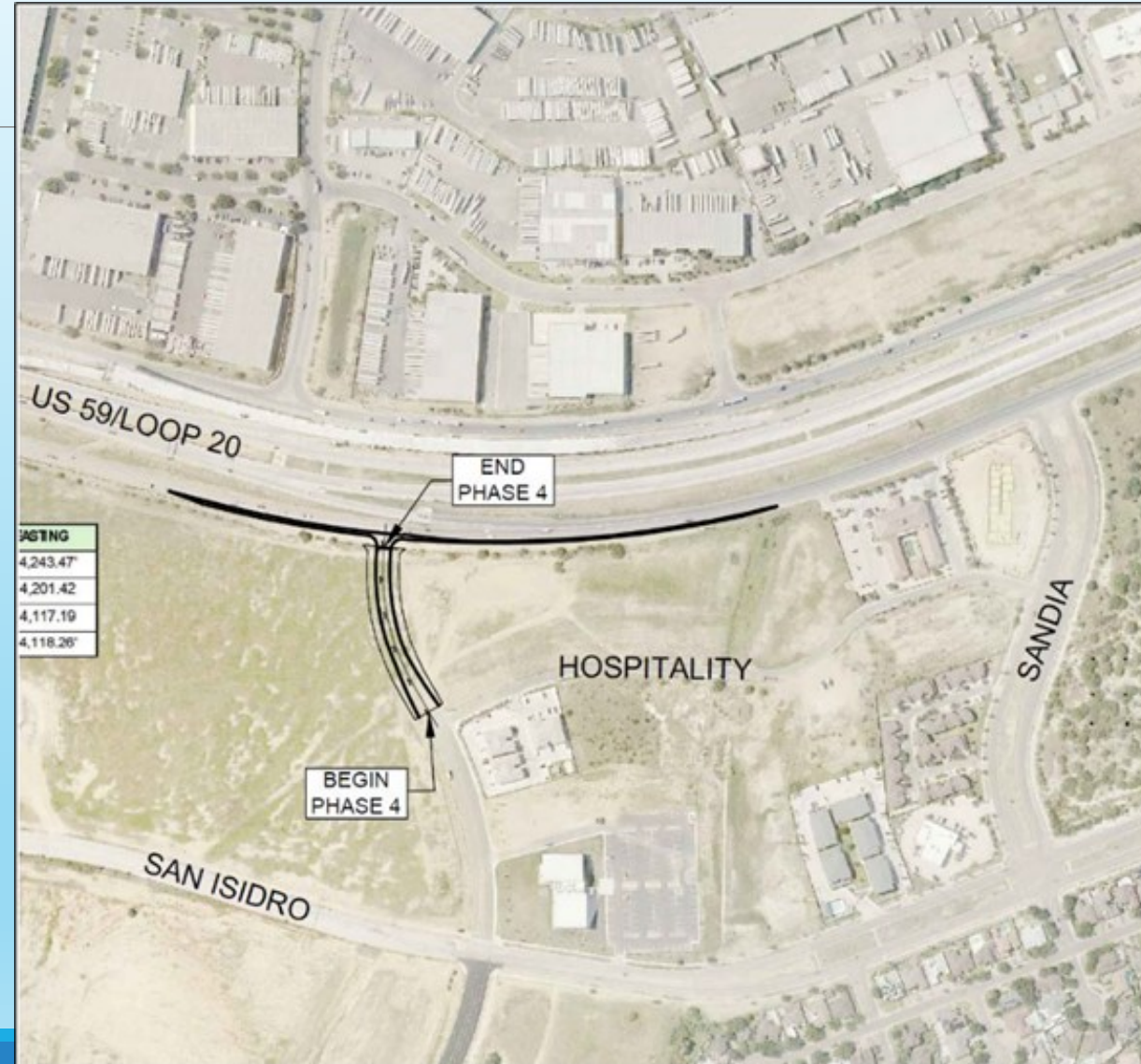




Projects Under Development

Springfield Phase IV

- WC-CL RMA: \$765,299 – construction funding
- TxDOT: \$577,000 – construction funding, connection to Loop 20
- City of Laredo: \$82,000 – project development funding
- Groundbreaking event: March 24, 2025
- Construction estimated duration: 90 days

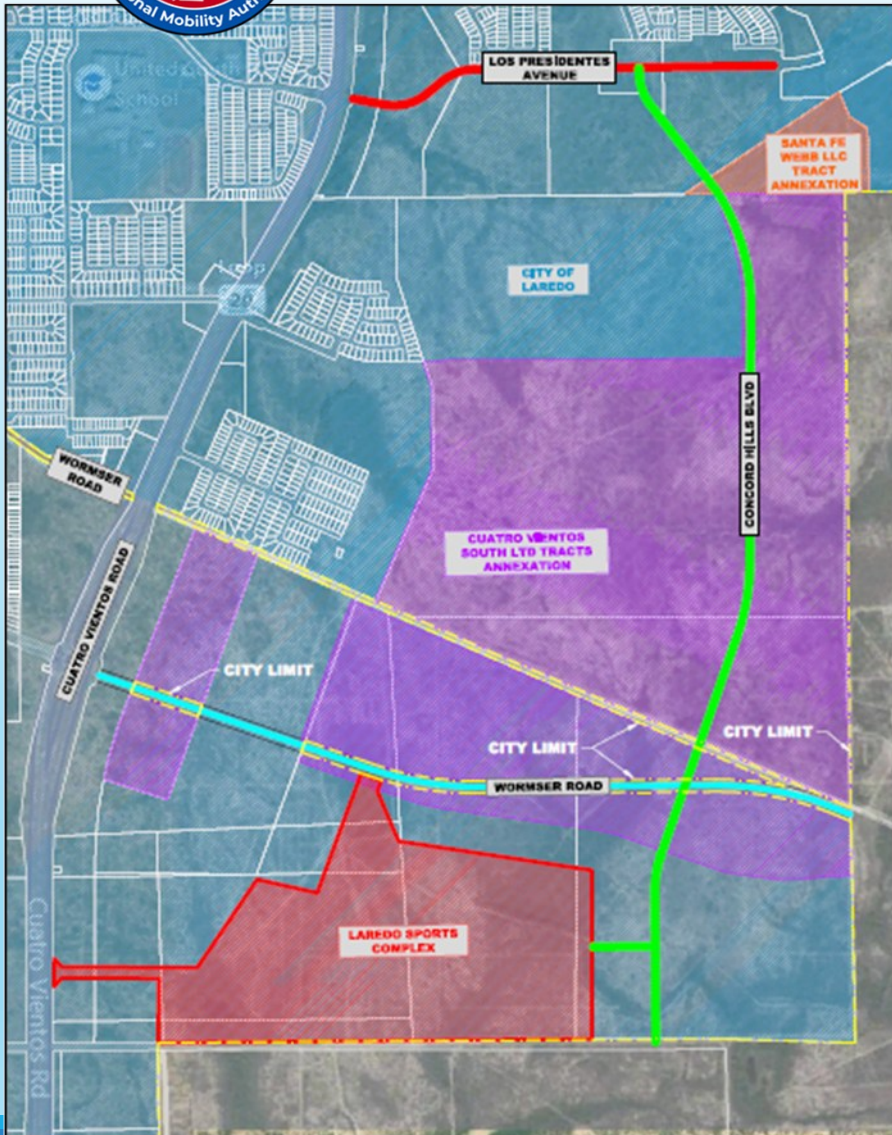

 - Webb County Drainage District



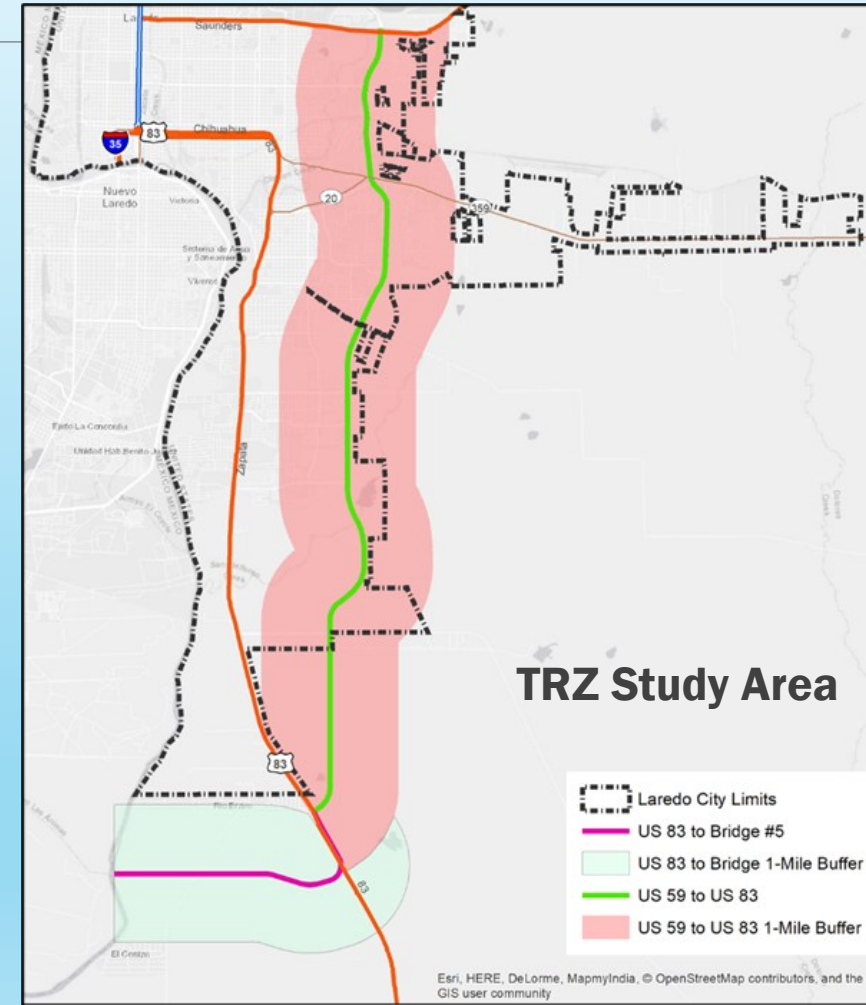


Projects Under Development

Cuatro Vientos Transportation Reinvestment Zone (TRZ) Creation



- City of Laredo approved an ILA March 19, 2025
- RMA / City of Laredo each committed \$50,000
- tool for generating funding for transportation projects
- captures/leverages economic growth that results from a transportation infrastructure project
- specific dedication of the incremental tax revenues generated within the boundaries of a TRZ





Projects Under Development

North Laredo Transportation Reinvestment Zone (TRZ) Study

- City of Laredo approved an ILA March 19, 2025
- RMA / City of Laredo each committed \$44,013.71
- Tool for generating funding for transportation projects
- Study assesses the potential for future incremental tax funds
- Provides possible study area and funding scenarios
